The new ANSI A92 standards require everyone who uses a MEWP to re-evaluate or create a safe use plan, including step-by-step process for assessing risks and hazards on the job.

- Compliance requires all your operators and spotters to be trained.
- Your trainer is certified and authorized to train you via online and hands-on instruction.
- This course is completed within 3 hours, from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. online.
- The hands-on portion of the training will be scheduled separately.

OSHA 10-Hour Outreach Training (Construction)

Provides a general overview of common job-related health and safety hazards. When you complete the program, you will earn a DOL (US Dept. of Labor) card. This shows OSHA and employers that you've met your OSHA training requirements.

- Covered over 2 days, starts at 8 a.m.
- Taught by an OSHA-Authorized Outreach trainer.
- Covers 29 CFR 1926 regulations.

OSHA 30-Hour Outreach Training (Construction)

Designed to give supervisors a broader and deeper understanding of job-related health and safety hazards. When you complete the program, you will earn a DOL (US Dept. of Labor) card.

- Covered over 4 days in person, starts at 8 a.m.
- Taught by an OSHA-Authorized Outreach trainer.
- Covers 29 CFR 1926 regulations.
